As reported, on May 8, 2019, the Georgia Federal Court entered an Order dismissing a majority of SmileDirectClub's

claims in the lawsuit (SmileDirectClub, LLC v. Georgia Board of Dentistry et al., Case No. 1:18cv-02328). The Court rejected SmileDirectClub's claim seeking a ruling that its digital scanning of patients' teeth does not constitute the "practice of dentistry or dental hygiene." The Court called this argument "incorrect".
