AAO Trustee Report

The AAO and Smile Direct Club

On April 11, 2017, the AAO sent complaints to 36 state dental boards concerning Smile Direct Club (SDC), alleging that the company has violated specific statutes and regulations that are in place to protect

the public. The AAO believes SDC's business model is illegal in those states, as it is seemingly bypassing state laws requiring a licensed professional to provide dental services, and prohibiting the splitting of fees, among other things. Circumventing such laws and standards can, and has, resulted in harm to the public.

State laws generally define the practice of dentistry to include taking dental impressions and providing dental appliances to patients-leaving little doubt that SDC's business model violates certain states' unauthorized practice of dentistry laws.

Western University Schulich School of Medicine and Dentistry Division of Graduate Orthodontics and Dentofacial Orthopedics Chairman and Program Director, Dr. A.H. Mamandras





Western University (UWO) is located in the "Forest City" London, Ontario (population 380,000) and has a fulltime enrollment of 35,000 students. The graduate program in Orthodontics was the only Western clinical dental specialty program until recently when the graduate program in Oral and Maxilofacial Surgery was established in 2007.

The Western graduate orthodontics program was established in 1973 by W.S. Hunter, Program Director and D.C. Way, Clinic Director as a two year program with a thesis component leading to a Master of Clinical Dentistry Degree under the aegis of the School of Graduate and Postdoctoral studies. Under the Directorship of A.H. Mamandras in 1994 the program was extended to 36 months.

The entrance to the graduate orthodontics program is very competitive. While top dental graduates from the two dental schools in Ontario comprise a fair proportion of those admitted to the graduate orthodontic program, successful applicants have come from every Canadian Province, the United States as well as Europe, Australia, Africa, and Asia. Western University and its affiliated colleges offer an exceptional international student climate with rich cultural diversity, to the benefit of all graduate and undergraduate students.

ABO Update

Clinical Exam Update: The ABO conducted its clinical examinations on February 20-25 and September 25-29, 2017 in St. Louis. 115 new examinees and 24 certification renewal examinees participated in the February exam. A total of 139 examinees participated in the February clinical exam and 97 were certified or recertified at this exam. 91% of the examinees were recent orthodontic graduates. In the September examination 123 doctors participated in the exam. 127 Orthodontists were ABO certified or recertified during this exam period. 76% were recent graduates. Residents from 69 orthodontic programs participated in the clinical examination. Clinical Examination Dates for 2018, including registration information, are posted on the ABO website.
