# AAOF AWARDS PROGRAM

Since the inception of the AAOF Awards Program, the Foundation has funded more than \$16.1 million in research and educational support. Last year, the Board approved funding of 22 awards totaling \$435,090. In January, the Planning and Awards Committee (PARC) will review 50 applications to determine funding for 2025. Your generosity allows AAOF to continue to advance the specialty.

2024 Awards from GLAO included Dr. Lacopo Cioffi from University of Toronto and Dr. Kenneth Stephen, III from University of Pittsburgh. Their awards totaled \$46,000.
